### **GUIDELINES FOR CofC CAMP USE OF CAMP POWDERFORK**

1. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas only.
2. There will be no use of “Silly String” on the campgrounds. It is not environmentally friendly.
3. No Screens are to be removed from any window.
4. The use of the “sound equipment must be approved by the Resident manager and/or the Campground Board Chairman. Sound equipment will remain locked at all times.
5. All buildings will remain locked unless Camp Director or his/her designee asks for them to be opened.
6. The Camp Director or his/her designee must be present to “open” their camp and to close their camp. This must be the same person both at opening and closing. If your camp is scheduled to open at 11:00 and close at 3:00. That means that there will be no access to the buildings (weather permitting) until 11:00 and that the opening “walk through” has been completed. That also means that the Camp Director or his/her designee has to have their camp meetings schedule to finish up in enough time to give the clean-up crews ample time to do their job thoroughly and efficiently, before the closing of your camp. Ideally no camper should be allowed to leave until the camp has passed the inspection of the last walk through. In this case that would be 3:00. In turn parents should be notified of this and not expect to arrive early to pick up their children.
7. Arrangements can be made for scheduled deliver of food products and other items before the scheduled opening time of you camp. This does not necessarily mean that the Resident Caretaker will be available for “unloading” of your commodities.
